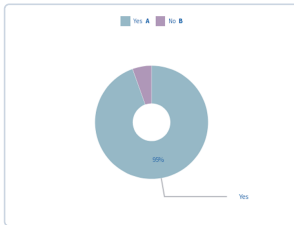

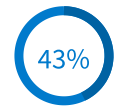

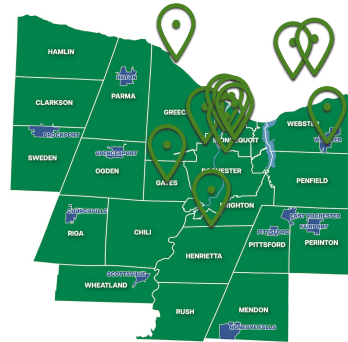

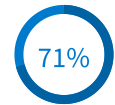
How would you rank the focus areas in order of importance for Monroe County?
